REPAIR OR RENOVATION OF DILAPIDATED BRIDGES

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of small/big bridges in India which are required to be repaired or renovated, district-wise;
- (b) the steps being taken by Government for repair or renovation of these dilapidated and dangerous bridges;
- (c) the expenditure likely to be incurred for the purpose; and
- (d) the time by when the said work is likely to be completed?

ANSWER

(a) to (d) Maintenance and development of National Highways including bridges thereon is a continuous process. Accordingly, repair / renovation / reconstruction of existing distressed/dilapidated bridges are taken up on annual basis depending upon condition of bridges, their functional and other requirements and inter-se-priority. Repair / renovation / reconstruction of such bridges are taken up either on standalone basis or as part of improvement/ upgradation of a section of National Highway. Cost of repair / renovation/ reconstruction of bridges are estimated on entire project basis including road and other provisions.
